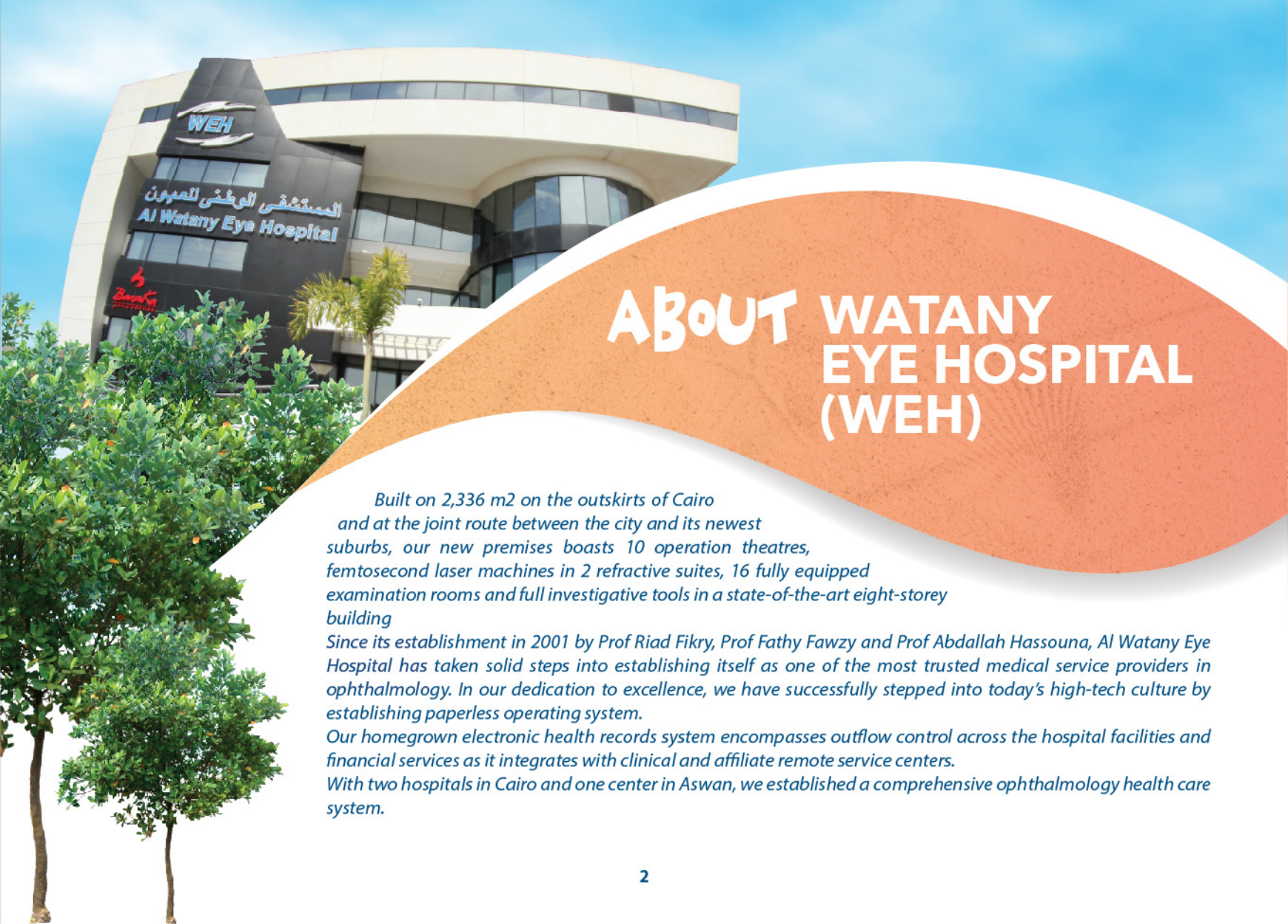

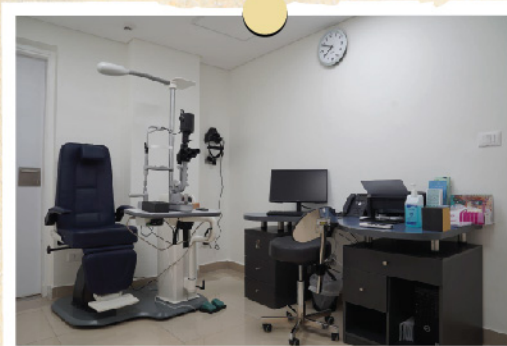

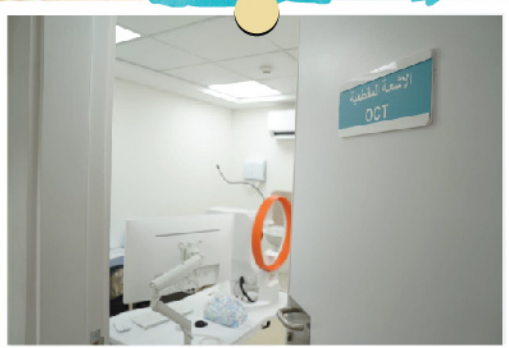

The experts team of the WEH, provides their consultations to their patients, through 6 fully equipped clinics.

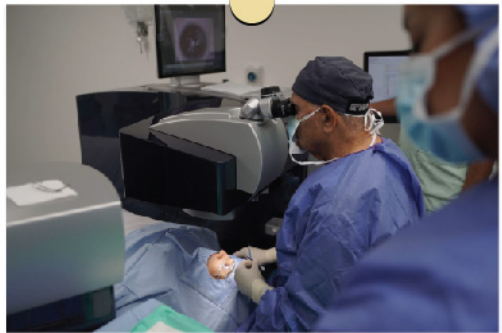
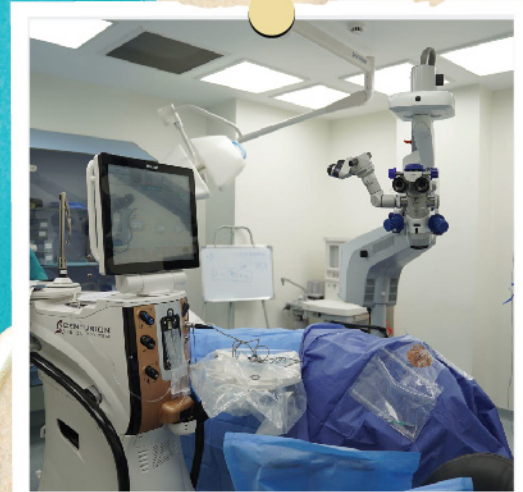


The laser treatments unit is equipped with machines needed to deliver proper management of a wide range of anterior and posterior conditions.

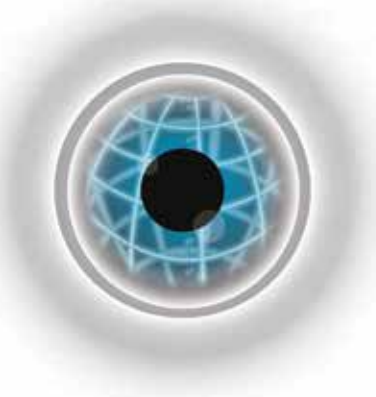



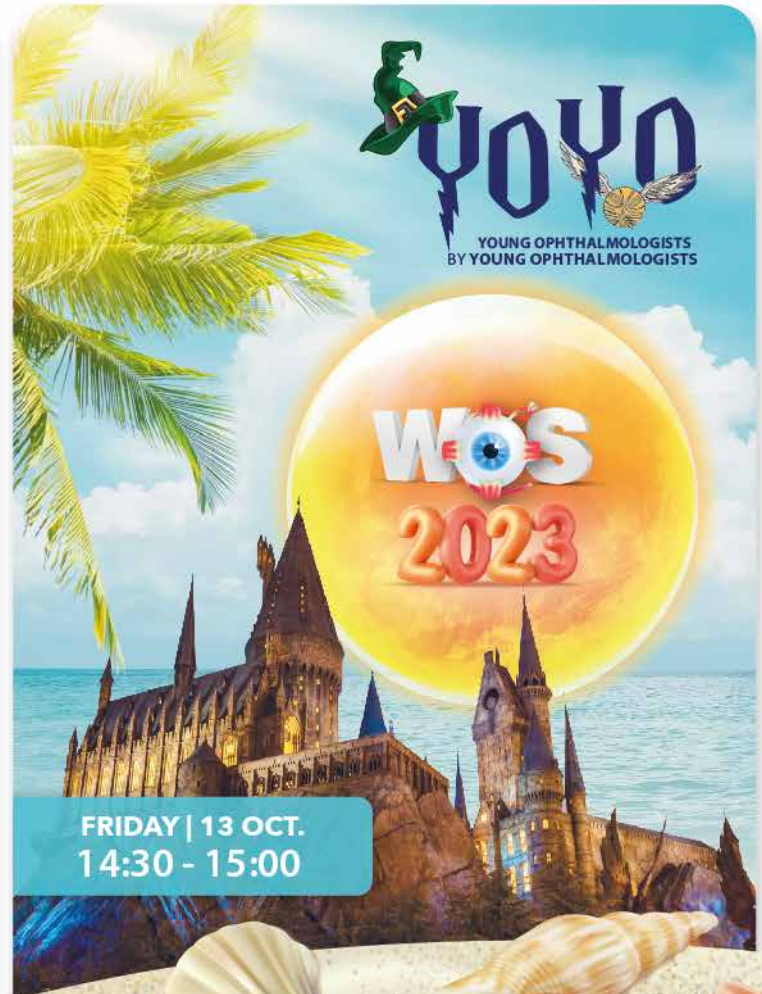
